

## **STRIPED SCARF 4 TEEN**

Pattern No. IR109



**Size:** 198 x 15 cm without the fringe, fringe – 25 cm (full length - 50 cm)

**Yarn:** King Cole Smooth [100% Acrylic Microfiber]; 2 x 100g /216 m skeins in col. 829 (cherry red), 2 x 100g /216 m skeins in col. 801 (winter white)

**Needles:** 3.75 mm circular or straight, and 3 mm metallic crochet hook

**Tension:** 10x10 cm (4") = 22 sts and 30 rows

### **Basic pattern, stockinette stitch:**

1<sup>st</sup> row (right side): Knit

2<sup>nd</sup> row (wrong side): Purl

3<sup>rd</sup> row: rep from 1<sup>st</sup> row

Cast on 64 sts with 3.75 mm needles. Work in stockinette 198 cm, alternating 32 rows in col. 829 and col. 801, starting with the col. 829. Cast off all sts at once. Sew the sides of the scarf along its length, turn it inside out, and iron the seam on low heat through a wet cloth. Do not sew the small, bottom sides, as your scarf needs to be a tube. Fringe: make 50 cm strands, 64 in col. 829 and 64 in col. 801. Attach the white fringe, using 3 mm metallic crochet hook, to the red bottom side of the scarf, and red fringe to the white side. The length of the finished fringe should be 25 cm. Using a wet cloth, slightly steam the fringe from the both sides, making sure that it lies evenly on the ironing board. Cut uneven ends. Leave scarf flat to dry.
